GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO PARENTS AND STUDENTS

Very Important - The Safety of our Children

1. Parents of small children shall accompany the child and help the child to board the bus in the morning, and receive the child by waiting on the left side (door side) of the bus in the evening.

This is very important because small children lack the knowledge of traffic rules. They have a tendency to run and cross the road in a hurry as soon as they get down from the bus. Therefore, parents are requested to come and hold the child when they get down from the bus; and cross the road only after the school bus has left the bus stop.

Parents are requested to remind the children constantly about the basics of traffic rules so that we can avoid the dangers and accidents.

- 2. Students are requested to keep the school bus timings and wait at the left side (door side) of the bus to board in the morning.
- 3. Regular attendance in class is an important factor for good education. Taking leave during working days is not an acceptable practice. A student will not be promoted to the next higher class if his/her attendance fails below 80%. Exceptionally valid cases only will be condoned to maximum extent of 15% shortage.

- 4. All students must attend classes on the opening day after each vacation. Absence is strictly prohibited before or after vacation or long holidays and will be viewed very seriously if no prior permission is obtained by the parents from the principal.
- 5. Please do not send the child to school if he/she is suffering from any illness, especially, if the child is suffering from any contagious disease like Chickenpox, Conjunctivities (sore eyes), etc.

If a child suffers from chickenpox, send him/her to school only after a minimum period of 12 days.

- 6. Parents shall watch and guide their children's studies at home. Parents should provide their children a favourable atmosphere for study at home. Please do not take any stringent measures of coaching them by resorting to physical punishments or mental torture. Taking such measures will not only ruin the children's education but also their future life.
- 7. Application for leave has to be applied for, in the School Diary, if it is for 1-3 days, and sanction obtained from the Class Teacher.
- 8. Leave for more than 3 days has to be sought by the parents in a separate application addressed to the Principal and sanction obtainer. Parents must send a medical certificate if it is for the health reasons.
- 9. Parents are requested to write the child's name, class and division on his/her belongings such as bags, books, water bottles, tiffin carriers, umbrellas etc.

- 10. Letters/circulars sent to parents must be properly and promptly responded.
- 11. Parents are requested not to allow children to bring C.Ds. IPods, cameras, mobile phones, video games or similar gadgets to the school. Violation results seizure of the item and will not be given back.
- 12. Parents and students are discouraged from giving any kind of gifts to teachers and staff.
- 13. Parents are welcomed to meet the teachers on all Saturday between 10-00 am and 12-00 noon (except on public holidays) in order to discuss about their children's day to day progress and behaviour.
- 14. Parents visiting school on a working day must go to the school office and not the staff room or class rooms. Parents are requested not to disturb teachers during working hours.
- 15. Students are not permitted to bring money to the school, unless there is a clear instruction from the school to bring money for a particular purpose.
- 16. Girls can wear black hair clips and black rubber bands. Colorful hair clips, hair bands, etc., are discouraged.
- 17. Children are not permitted to wear gold ornaments and expensive watches. Boys are restricted to wear metal bangles.

18. Colour Dress Not Allowed on Birthday

Students are not allowed to wear colour dresses during birthdays. Colour dress is discouraged as we find children wearing dresses that are not suitable or decent. Moreover, this is not serving the purpose of uniformity among students. Also sweets should not be distributed, instead children can donate books to the school Library.

- 19. Students have to come to school in uniform even when they come to attend special classes, library or other programmes on Saturdays or holidays.
- 20. Boys shall not grow long hair and should have a decent hair cut.
- 21. Students should clean their finger nails and trim them regularly. Nails should not be polished with any colours.
- 22. The School diary is a record concerning the students. Therefore, students should take special care of it and bring to the school regularly. If a student loses it, he/she should buy a duplicate one paying Rs. 100/-
- 23. During working hours, taking the children out requires the permission of the Principal and the details must be entered in the movement register.
- 24. During working hours phone calls to teachers and drivers by parents are strictly prohibited.
- 25. Temporary change of bus is strictly discouraged. However, if very necessary prior permission must be received from the office.

TESTS / EXAMS AND EVALUATION

The Performance of students will be continuously assessed by means of oral test, written test, worksheet, project neatness, involvement and response in classes and other activities. We also conduct Unit Tests, Half Yearly Exam and Annual Exam.

For KG Section:

The Tests/Exams shown in this diary are not applicable to the children of the Kindergarten section. The KG children will have only informal tests. However, at every stage we expect children to achieve certain specific learning outcomes. Play school children have no tests at all.

N.B.: If any Test/Exam day becomes a holiday unexpectedly that day's Test/Exam will be held on the next working day.

CO - CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Sports and Games

The school provides Physical Education facilities and indoor games. Sports activities are conducted in the school ground. Activities like Yoga, Coaching Classes for Chess are also provided at the campus.

Talent Show

Once in a month every House gets an opportunity to perform their talents before the whole section. The students

present literary cultural and recreational items with the guidance of the class teacher. It is not a competition but a win-win co-operative show exhibiting the talents of every student, individually as well as in groups. The inherent talents of children are recognized and appreciated by this programme. Children also develop their talents in different areas.

House Activities

To impart a healthy competitive spirit among the students and to inculcate the habit of working together and developing leadership qualities, an efficient House System has been introduced in the school. Each house is guided and cared by a House Captain. Occassionally, interhouse competitions are conducted and evaluated.

A number of co-curricular activities are organized during the academic year. They include singing, dancing, dramatics, public speaking, debating, talk show, quiz, essay writing, versification, drawing, painting, etc.
